Shannon told the story of her family's journey from March, 2013 to October, 2016 battling cancer that attacked their little 5-year-old Skyla. The support the family received from the school, community members, churches during that time was invaluable to maintain strength to continue the fight. Unfortunately, Skyla was not healed on earth but earned her healing and angel wings on October 25, 2016. Brian shared about the wonderful support the family received in giving Skyla and the family beautiful, happy, fun-filled days together before her move to heaven. The family established a foundation, Skyla Strong, to provide that support to others in the same situation they found themselves facing in 2016. The Mission of Skyla Strong is to bring cheer to the cancer journey. Baskets are delivered to the hospital for children battling cancer. The baskets contain activities and toys for the children to help pass the time and gift cards for the family to help with meals and fuel expenses. Skyla Strong also funds activities for the family like trips to a zoo, museum, or the beach as well as having family portraits made by a professional photographer.

Lion Treasurer, Becky Bagwell presented a check to Skyla Strong for \$1000. The club had agreed to give \$500 and individual donations added to that amount came to \$1000.
